#### OPEN SPECIAL MEETING AND CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Rohrmoser opened the special meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. The purpose of the meeting was to work on the 2019/2020 budget and any other business necessary.

The Board discussed upcoming expenses. Chief Collins requested a 2% increase in the fire department budget. A reserve fund will be set up for a new tractor. Clerk Mattison incorporated these figures into the tentative budget of the General and Water Funds.

The proposed tax rate is \$4.50 per thousand of assessed valuation. The semi-annual water rate is \$60 per 25,000 gallons and \$3.00 per thousand thereafter, with an EDU rate of \$115. The proposed annual compensation to be paid to the Mayor is \$4,223 and \$3,183 to each Trustee.

No additional budget meetings will be necessary.
