Agenda Item Five | SCRPB:

The following resolution was proposed, moved, seconded and adopted:

WHEREAS, the Village of Sandy Creek and the Town of Sandy Creek have previously established a joint municipal planning board known as the Sandy Creek Regional Planning Board pursuant to Village Law §7-718, Town Law §271, and General Municipal Law Article 5-G; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lacona has expressed a desire to join the Sandy Creek Regional Planning Board and participate in coordinated planning, subdivision, and site plan review; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees (“Village Board”) of the Village of Sandy Creek finds that the inclusion of the Village of Lacona will enhance regional planning and further the purposes of Village Law §§7-718, 7-741 and General Municipal Law Article 5-G;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, the Village Board hereby consents to and approves the entry of the Village of Lacona into the Sandy Creek Regional Planning Board, subject to the execution of an intermunicipal agreement among the participating municipalities; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village of Sandy Creek Mayor is authorized and directed to execute said intermunicipal agreement on behalf of the Village, subject to approval as to form by counsel; and

Upon motion made by Trustee Sharon Turo, and seconded by Mayor Lynn Miller, the foregoing resolution was put to a roll call, which resulted as follows:
